

ADMISSION ELIGIBILITY (B. Arch)

Available Seats Seats available for admission process are known as:

• Government Seats (process done by ACPC)

- I. All the sanctioned seats of Bachelor of Architecture, In the Government Colleges or Institutions of the State;
- II. All the sanctioned seats of Bachelor of Architecture, In the aided Colleges or Institutions;
- III. Fifty percent (50%) of the total sanctioned seats of Bachelor of Architecture, in the Unaided Colleges or Institutions, and
- IV. All supernumerary seats of the professional courses, in the Government Colleges or Institutions and in the aided and unaided Colleges or Institutions.

Management Seats (process done by Institute (Unaided)

- I. Fifty percent (50%) seats of the total sanctioned seats of the Bachelor of Architecture in the unaided Colleges or Institutions, including fifteen (15%) percent NRI seats;
- II. The intimation received, in respect of sanction of seats, by the Admission Committee three days prior to the counseling program, shall be considered as available seats.

Provided that the Government Seats shall be offered for online admission for two rounds by the Admission Committee:

Provided further that the registration and preparation of merit list of the Management Seats shall be managed, finalized and declared by the concerned college or institution.



Qualifying Examination Eligibility (for the year 2020-2021)

Bachelor of Architecture Course

A candidate shall have passed the qualifying examination of 10+2 scheme with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics subjects and have obtained valid score in the NATA as prescribed by Council.

OR

A candidate shall have passed the qualifying examination of 10+3 Diploma scheme with Mathematics as a compulsory subject and have obtained valid score in the NATA as prescribed by Council.

Reservation for Admission

[A] For the purpose of admission in Government Seats, the seats shall be reserved under the following categories and in following proportion, namely: -

(a) Scheduled Castes : 7 %

(b) Scheduled Tribes : 15%

(c) Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (SEBC), : 27%

including Widows and orphan of any caste

(d) Economically Weaker Sections(EWSs) : 10%

including Widows and orphan of any caste

[B] For the purpose of admission in Government Seats, the seats shall be reserved under the following as sub-category in each of the available category and in following proportion, namely:-

(a) Physically Disable candidate (more than 40%) : 5 %

(b) In-Serviceman and Ex- Serviceman : 1%
