UNIVERSITY PROFILE

Established by the State Legislature Act 28 of 2014 on July 24, 2014, CSRU has a sprawling campus of 75 acres situated 2 kilometers from Gohana Bypass, Jind. The university was established with the vision of imparting quality education by creating most conducive ambience for the production and dissemination of knowledge guided by innovative thinking, scientific enquiry, sublime human values, sustainable ecology, and democratic ethos. The aim of the University is the cultivation of citizens with a rich awareness of our heritage to lead and serve in every sphere of human activity. Working under the leadership of eminent educationists and social reformers, Hon'ble Chancellor Prof. Kaptan Singh Solanki and dedicated, dynamic and devoted personality Vice- Chancellor Prof. R.B. Solanki, the University is heading towards realization of its vision and the goal of being in the world ranking by 2020.

The University is affiliated u/s 2(f) and 12 (B) of the UGC Act, 1956 vide letter no. 9-12/2014(CPP-I/PU) dated 26 September 2014 and is also a member of the Association of Indian Universities. In a short span of four years, the university has many achievements to its credit.

In addition to the academics the students are also encouraged to participate in sports events and extracurricular activities at the campus as well as outside the campus the enable their wholesome personality development.

The university has a newly constructed academic block with latest infrastructure and newly constructed Laxmi Bai Girls Hostel with ultra-modern facilities. The central library of the university has the stock of approximately 16000 books. It subscribes to National and International refereed journals, magazines and periodicals and also subscribes many Hindi and English newspapers. Round the clock internet facility is also available in the library premises. The university has an impressive Language Lab, which is open for all the students of the university to help them to improve their communication skills. The university also has a Computer lab well equipped with the latest software and is networked with 32 mbps internet speed with fiber optical device. The Psychology lab of the university is spacious and fully equipped with latest equipment to carry out the tests. The Conference room of the university is equipped with world class facilities with a seating capacity of 40 persons. The construction for the extension of academic block, Second Computer Lab, Administrative Block, Boys Hostel, Sports Stadium and residential quarters for faculty is in full swing. The students of this university have shown commendable results in academics as well as co-curricular activities. With the present pace of progress, the university looks forward to having a promising future.

UNIVERSITY LIBRARY

Libraries are an integral part of all educational institutes in India. The library of the university is well equipped with large numbers of books. The library has subscribed many newspapers. It is planned to shift the

library to its new building from the coming session i.e. 2020-21. It will be well equipped with the modern technology and infrastructure. Recently, an E-Kiosk system has also been installed for the convenience of the students as well as faculty members. The library also provides AC reading rooms where the readers can study peacefully. The library remains open from 9.00 A.M. to 5.00 P.M. The library recorded about 500 users including students and staff of the university.

LAXMI BAI GIRLS' HOSTEL

The University has one Girls hostel named after the Queen of Jhansi, Rani Laxmi Bai. It has the capacity of accommodating 240 girls. The hostel is provided with electronic gadgets including electric geysers, 32" Plasma TVs along with Dish/DTH facility and water cooler with RO system. The hostels subscribe to several national and regional dailies and magazines for enabling the students to know what is happening around the world. Sport facilities for girls include table tennis and badminton court, Volley ball court, gym and different indoor games like carom-board and chess etc. Medical facilities to all hostel residents are provided through the University Health Centre located in the Hostel premises. The University also has a Horticulture Club maintained by the girls of the Hostel. Beauty and skin care clinic has been established for the grooming of the students. The hostel on the campus operates its own mess providing hygienic and nutritious meals with a varied menu. In view of the large number of students applying for hostel accommodation, the university allows hostel to the students on the basis of their merit in the admission list.

CHHATRAPATI SHIVAJI CHHATRAWAS FOR BOYS

The University has a hostel after the name of great Indian Freedom Fighter, Chhatrapati Shivaji. It has capacity to accommodate 200 Students. The hostel has following facilities:

1. Reading Hall Fully Air Conditioned.
2. 125 KV Generators for 24 Hrs. Power Supply.
3. Water Cooler along with RO Purifier.
4. Electric Water Geysers
5. Recreational Room equipped with 42 Inch Plasma TV alongwith D2H Connection.
6. Subscription of Several National on Regional dailies and magazines.
7. Sports facility includes Table Tennis, Badminton Court and other indoor game like Carom Board and Chess etc.
8. State of Arts Dinning Facility.
9. CCTV Surveillance.
10. Well furnished guest rooms for parents and visitors

The Hostel on the Campus operates its own mess providing hygienic and nutritious meals with a varied menu. In of the large number of students applying for hostel accommodation, the University allows hostel to the students on the basis of their merit in the admission.

UNIVERSITY HEALTH CENTRE

The Health Centre located in a separate building has sufficient space for a dispensary with patient Beds and stools with drop stand. The centre has a visiting doctor, pharmacist and a nurse and provides medical consultation and free medicines to all students and staff. The health centre is well equipped with all basic apparatus and general medicines. The Health Centre also provides first line of treatment in emergency cases. The process for the full-fledged development of university health centre is in process and will be accomplished soon.

UNIVERSITY COMPUTER & INFORMATICS CENTRE (UCIC)

The University Computer & Informatics Centre (UCIC) is striving to develop the University as "Digital University" and working rigorously to provide the excellent infrastructure facilities with High end systems controlled by Dell Make power Server. Central UPS with a power back up of 8 hours is controlling all the Computer Systems connected via optical fiber LAN covering the whole Campus. 24*7 Internet facility with 200 Mbps is available for students as well as staff members. UCIC is continuously monitoring and updating all the information on university website. The UCIC established a Computer Centre with the objective of providing readily available facilities of computers to the students and teaching and non-teaching staff of the University. It also purports to automate administrative and secretarial wings of the University with the aim to cater to the needs of the entire University. University Computer & Informatics Centre (UCIC) is providing opportunity to enhance Professional Knowledge among students and staff members. One Language lab established to improve communication skills of the student in order to compete in the era of Globalization.

LANGUAGE LAB

The Language lab has been established to improve communication skills of the students. The Lab is equipped with latest software related to English Language and Communication. It provides a host of opportunities for students to work with online exercise sheets and virtual practice sessions, thus enabling them to learn language in a simulated environment.

PANDIT DEEN DAYAL UPADHAYAYA CENTRE

The Pandit Deen Dayal Upadhayay Centre is established in CRSU, Jind for the following objectives:

- a. **Antyodaya School:** This school is established in university campus for giving free of cost education to the deprived students.
- b. **Unnat Bharat Abhiyan:** The purpose of this abhiyan is to increase awareness to villagers regarding Govt. scheme, Water conservation, Entrepreneurship programs etc. The tree plantation and Training/Camps/Seminars is conducted time to time in villages for public awareness.
- c. **Bharat Bodh Gallery:** The main objective of this gallery is to aware students of university, colleges and schools about historical person and their achievements in life.

d. **Human Transformation:** The objectives of this program are to encourage students to be entrepreneurs, seminars and lectures for student's awareness regarding carrier information, coaching for SSC-CGL & UGC-NET. Another objective of this program is encouraging cooperative culture amongst the students and makes them good citizens of the country.

SC/ST CELL

The SC/ST Cell has been established for the welfare of SC/ST students of the University as per the instructions of the UGC/State Government. The Cell also functions as a Grievances Redressal Cell for the grievances of the SC/ST students and employees of the University and provides them necessary help in solving their academic as well as administrative problems. The Cell also performs any other work assigned from time to time to promote higher education among the communities suffering from economic, social and educational deprivations. The main objective of the SC/ST Cell is to ensure proper implementation of various schemes of University Grants Commission/Government of India/State Government introduced from time to time.

GUIDANCE AND COUNSELLING CELL

The Guidance and Counseling Cell of university was established in 2016 with the support of Hon'ble Vice- Chancellor. The Cell meets the following objectives:

- To assist the students in Career areas (Knowledge of different career options through Career Talks)
- To help them in Personal areas (Stress, anxiety, lack of self- confidence, communication skills, Development of Positive attitude, Assertiveness Training etc.)
- To provide assistance in academic areas (study habits, Time management, Goal Orientation etc.)

Different programs under guidance and counseling cell in last year were organized in different departments.

These programs were on Self Awareness, Communication Skills and enhancement of self-esteem.

During these years, many students were also provided personal counseling sessions from different departments regarding their, personal, educational and career issues.

TRAINING & PLACEMENT CELL

Training and Placement Cell will invite and host companies on campus to hold recruitments for our students and in spite of the job market looking bleak this time round consists of students from different courses in their final year. The aim is to invite companies from various fields in order to make opportunities available not just for students of business but also for the students of science and arts.

Training and Placement Cell will also organize workshops and job for them. In addition, Training and Placement Cell will also organize different activities to enhance the skills of the students like:

- Soft Skills Development
- Career Building
- Mock Group Discussions
- Mock Interviews

EQUAL OPPORTUNITY CELL

The university has constituted Equal opportunity cell to provide equal opportunity to all including the persons with disability. In addition, it will also examine all the possible ways in which SC/ST, OBC and all other minority groups could be helped.

VIGILANCE CELL

The university has constituted Vigilance cell to activate vigilance machinery for investigating complaints and sensitizing the university community against corruption and corrupt practices. The main objective of this cell is to prevent the possibilities of corruption and to encourage a culture of honesty and integrity.

RESEARCH CELL

The university has constituted the Research Cell to facilitate and promote quality research in emerging areas of higher education with focus on new frontiers and to act as a knowledge power- house capable of contributing to the national development and welfare of the society.

INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL

The university has constituted the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) for planning, guiding and monitoring quality enhancement activities of the University. The cell works to instill the spirit of quality consciousness and continuous improvement of academic and administrative performance of the University and to promote measures for institutional functioning towards quality enhancement through internalization of quality culture and institutionalization of best practices. In order to enhance the academic quality of the UTDs, the auditing of the departments is carried out from time to time. The university invites experts who suggest areas where the department needs to improve. All the internal audits are discussed in the meetings chaired by the Vice Chancellor, who provides directions for the implementation of the suggestions of the experts given in the audits. The IQAC is already in active mode for NAAC preparation. In this regard, a sufficient no. of workshops have been organized to make the departments aware about the importance of NAAC as well as necessary requirements for NAAC.

INTERNAL COMPLAINTS COMMITTEE (ICC) AGAINST SEXUAL HARASSMENT OF WOMEN AT WORK PLACE (PREVENTION, PROHIBITION AND REDRESSAL)

The University is committed to provide to all women a place of work and study free of sexual harassment, intimidation and exploitation. It is expected that all students, faculty, staff, karamcharis and officials treat one another and visitors to the University with respect. Reports of sexual harassment are taken seriously and dealt with promptly.

Sexual harassment can take place in various forms; some subtle and indirect, some blatant and overt. For instance any one or more of the following acts of unwelcome behavior (directly or by implication); physical contact and advances, A demand or request for sexual favours, Making sexually coloured remarks, Showing pornography, any other unwelcome physical, verbal or nonverbal conduct of sexual nature.

As per policy the University constitutes ICC every year representing different stakeholders. Students can take help of ICC without any hesitation. Complaints can be made directly to any member of ICC or through existing channels of lodging grievances, such as University Authorities, Wardens, Teachers, Students, Union/Association Representatives, and Administrative Superiors etc.

DIRECTORATE OF YOUTH WELFARE AND CULTURAL AFFAIRS

Directorate of Youth Welfare aims at ensuring the welfare of students by conceiving and organizing programmes for the establishment of a healthy cultural environment in the university. It motivates students to participate in various cultural activities to ensure their holistic development. Besides celebration of national festivals, the Directorate also organizes Talent Hunt Competitions.

SPORTS ACTIVITIES

Sports activities of the university are being run under the Sports Council. The university has the following playfields: Handball (1), Football (1), Volleyball (1), Netball (1), Korfball (1), Kho- Kho (1), Kabaddi (1), & Athletic Track 400 mtrs. The university is going to have its Sports Stadium soon. The university provides different sports facilities to its players taking part in the inter university tournaments like free TA & DA, sport kit & track suit, free medical facility and scholarship to the players winning positions in these tournaments.

NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME

National Service Scheme (NSS) promotes the spirit of voluntary work among the students and teachers through sustained community interactions. It brings academic institutions near to the society. It shows how to combine knowledge and action to achieve results, which are desirable for community development. NSS at Chaudhary Ranbir Singh University was established with the objective of providing the youth an opportunity to develop their overall personality by taking part in various Social Service Schemes. The University has initiated the process of students' enrolment. Students will be given opportunity to participate in state and national level camps. Merit certificates are provided to students, who perform well in the camps. The NSS unit organized special camp on digital financial literacy and four students also received appreciation from MHRD, Government of India.

BHARAT BODH GALLERY

The University has established Bharat Bodh Gallery for inculcating the values of National Pride and National Commitment, Teaching to live together for Social Harmony, Education about Bhartiya Sanskriti, Bhartiya Gyan and Gouravshali Bhartiya Itihas among students.

If the seats after 1st and 2nd Counselling for B.Ed., B.Ed. (Special), D.P.ED., B.P.Ed. and B.P.Es. Courses under Self Financing Scheme College of Education still remain vacant, then, 3rd counselling will be conducted by the Colleges at their own level and fee of Rs. 2,000/- (including late fees of Rs. 1,000/-) each student in 3rd counselling will be deposited in the University alongwith list of students who will apply for 3rd counselling.

Cut off date for eligibility will be the last date/time of online choice filling.

Note: After subsequent counseling for vacant/leftover seats in colleges of education, no further counselling shall be conducted by the Colleges for admission and no college shall be allowed to make admission beyond 15.12.2020 even if seats remain vacant, to meet the minimum requirement of 200 days compulsory teaching as per NCTE norms. Further the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court, Chandigarh has decided in the CWP No.-25707 of 2015 that once the last date has been notified by the admission making authority, therefore, there would be no extension under any circumstances.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS AT A GLANCE

1. Prospectus containing eligibility conditions, list of participating institutions with no. of sanctioned seats, code No. of Colleges/Institutes can be seen/downloaded from University website www.crsu.ac.in.
2. Before filling the online Application Form, the candidates are required to read the prospectus carefully. For any query, please contact the helpline telephone numbers for the applicants and for the colleges the same will be mentioned here after receiving from the concerned agency.
3. The Admission to B.Ed., B.Ed. (Special), D.P.Ed., B.P.Ed. and B.P.Es. Courses for the session 2020-21 will be made on the basis of inter-se merit of percentage of the Qualifying Examination through online counselling by C.R.S.U. Jind.
4. In case a candidate has passed the Master Degree Examination also after Bachelor Degree, the Higher percentage of marks obtained either in Under Graduate or Post Graduate degree of the two will be taken into consideration while preparing the merit.
5. No one who is already in employment (whole time or part time or in honorary capacity) shall be admitted to the B.Ed. (Regular) Course in any College of Education without taking leave from the employer for full academic session.
6. It will be the responsibility of the candidate to ensure eligibility for admission before applying for the course. If on verification at a later stage, it is found that a candidate does not fulfil the eligibility conditions, his/her candidature will be cancelled and the fee deposited by him/her shall be forfeited.
7. On-line registration-cum-counselling fee is Rs. 1000/-. Registration cum Counselling fee is non-refundable.
8. On-line registration-cum-Counselling fee shall be deposited by the candidate online through Credit / Debit Cards and Net Banking on the charges already fixed by IDBI.
9. All the candidates must verify their personal information during online registration.
10. Locking of submitted choices is advisable, however, candidates who do not lock the choices, their last filled choice would be considered final.
11. Registered candidates who do not fill choices or fail to save the same cannot be considered for admission and seat allotment.
12. Candidates must take print-out of their online Application Form along with their locked choices. This print-out has to be signed and submitted at the time of reporting for admission.
13. The outcome of counselling will be displayed on www.crsu.ac.in as per admission schedule. No individual allotment letter will be sent to the candidates. They will have to download by applying Registration and password allotted to them and report to the allotted college from the website i.e. www.crsu.ac.in.
14. All the candidates who are allotted seats will report to allotted college/institute within stipulated date, failing which their seat allotment shall stand cancelled. Also, they will not be considered for further Counsellings.

15. Candidates will produce all the relevant certificates in original including registration-cum-counselling fee receipt for verification along with provisional allotment letter, a signed print out of their online application form, their locked choices generated from the website at the time of reporting.
16. At the time of reporting, if documents are found to be correct on verification by the college then provisional admission/ auto up-gradation letter generated online will be issued to the candidate by the concerned college. The candidate shall check all the entries in this provisional admission/ auto up-gradation letter and should sign it and preserve it for further reference.
17. The allotment of seats is liable to be cancelled, if the personal data viz. Category, Group (Group-I Science & Arts with Maths, Group-II Arts & Commerce) residential status Bonafide Residents of Haryana or All India Category), percentage of marks in qualifying examination, gender etc. submitted by the candidates at the time of registration is found to be wrong at the time of verification of the original certificates at Allotted Institutes. But, if the candidate is found to be eligible after the correction in personal data, the candidate may be considered for subsequent rounds of counseling, if any, against the vacancies only.
18. If a candidate is admitted on the basis of the information submitted by him/ her, which is found to be incorrect or false at any stage then his/ her admission shall be cancelled and all fees and other dues paid by him/ her shall be forfeited. The University/ College/ Institute may take further action, as deemed fit, against the candidate in accordance with law.
19. Candidate seeking admission in self financing institutions are advised to ensure that they are lawfully admitted failing which, they shall not be authenticated by the CRSU. Jind and shall not be registered by the affiliating University and they themselves shall be responsible for any such lapse.
20. All the rules and regulations for submission of migration certificates by the candidates who have passed the qualifying examinations from other Universities will be applicable as per the rules of the University.
21. In case, a candidate after having deposited required fee for admission to B.Ed., B.Ed. (Special), D.P.Ed., B.P.Ed. and B.P.Es. Courses for the session 2020-21 decides to leave the said courses before the last round of counselling, the fee deposited by the candidate will be refundable to him/ her by the concerned college if the seat so vacated is filled by some other candidate after deducting Rs. 1000/- only.
22. In case of ambiguity about any rule, the interpretation of the same by the University shall be final.
23. All legal disputes relating to admission to these courses, will be subject to Courts having jurisdiction at Jind.
24. The number of colleges/sanctioned seats may increase or decrease based upon the approval and affiliation from the University.

25. Candidates are advised to consult the updated list of colleges on the website www.crsu.ac.in, before filling their choices as intake in various institutes subject to change by the competent authority in view of pending writs/appeals in courts/NCTE with regard to their recognition.
26. The attendance rules of the affiliating university will be applicable on the students.
27. The participating colleges/Institutions will ensure that all the admissions will be made only on the basis of the recognized and valid degree (s)/certificate (s) issued by the approved and recognized boards/Institutes/ Universities. In case any clarification of equivalence/recognition of qualifying degree/certificate/Institute/Board/University is required, the same may be obtained from the University.
28. All the updated latest information/notices/changes/modifications will be displayed on the University website.
29. The candidates are required to visit the website regularly to obtain the latest information.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COLLEGES

1. Every College shall constitute an Admission Committee to be appointed by the Principal from amongst the teachers of College.
2. Verification of the documents of the candidate will be made by the respective Admission Committee of College at the time of reporting for admission, by comparing with the original certificates against which candidate has been allotted seat. Any entry or information filled/ made by the candidate, if found to be false, shall entail automatic cancellation of admission.
3. The admission committee may ensure that the Candidate has deposited the fee as per his / her entitlement.
4. Online reporting should be done as and when candidate reports at institute and not on the last date of admission.
5. After successful admission of the candidate, the institute must issue system generated provisional admission slip/ auto up-gradation letter to candidate.
6. Colleges are required to update admission status online on www.crsu.ac.in strictly as per admission schedule so that the subsequent counseling may be conducted as per schedule, failing which they will be fined heavily.
7. All admissions by colleges are to be updated/ reported online, as and when they admit the candidates. No permission of any kind would be provided for admitting students, if status of admission not reported online as per Key dates/schedule.
8. Information about only those candidates, whose admission status has been reported online, will be forwarded to Registration Branch of University
9. Responsibility for any wrong/irregular/excess admission will entirely rest upon the Principal concerned.
10. Admission of candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from other University shall be provisional subject to verification of the eligibility by the Registration Branch of the University.
11. All the rules and regulations for submission of Registration Return of students by the college will be applicable as per the rules of the University concerned.
12. Every College must give accurate information on its website regarding human and instructional resources along with subjects in which teachers are available in the College.
13. Under no circumstances the original certificates of the candidate should be retained by the college. The candidate seeking admission will submit two sets of his/ her documents/ certificates duly Self attested by Candidate, at the time of reporting in the college. The Principal of the college will authenticate these documents/ certificates after comparing these from the originals and the originals will be returned to the candidate. One set of these documents/ certificates thus authenticated by the college shall be deposited in the affiliating University, for the purpose of registration, for which no original certificate shall be demanded. Anyhow, if the affiliating University, so desires the original certificates from the candidate can be demanded through the institute of his/ her admission for any purpose what so ever these may be.

Eligibility Conditions for Admission to B.Ed., B.Ed. (Special Education) Two Year Regular Course as per NCTE Norms is as under:

Candidates with at least 50% marks (47.5 in case of SC/ST/Blind/Visually and Differently Abled Candidates of Haryana only) either in the Bachelor Degree and/or in the Master Degree in Science/Social Science /Humanity, Bachelor's in Engineering or Technology with specialization in Science and Mathematics with 55% marks (52.55% in case of SC/ST/Blind/Visually and Differently Abled Candidates of Haryana only) or any other qualification equivalent thereto, are eligible for admission to the Programs.1

Eligibility Conditions for Admission to D.P.Ed. Two Year Regular Course as per NCTE Norms is as under:

Senior Secondary School (+2) or its equivalent examination passed with at least 50% marks.

However, 5% relaxation be given to those who have participated in International/National/SGFI Sports Competition.

The relaxation in the percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC and other categories shall be as per the rules of the Central Government/State Government, whichever is applicable.

Eligibility Conditions for Admission to B.P.Ed. Two Year Regular Course as per NCTE Norms is as under:

(a) Bachelor's degree in any discipline with 50% marks and having at least participation in the inter-College/Inter-Zonal/ District/School competition in sports and games as recognized by the AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India.

Or

(b) Bachelor's degree in physical education with 45% marks.

Or

(c) Bachelor's degree in any discipline with 45% marks and studied physical education as compulsory elective subject.

Or

(d) Bachelor's degree with 45% marks and having participated in National/Inter University/State Competitions or secured 1st, 2nd or 3rd position in Inter College/Inter-Zonal/District/School competition in sports and games as recognized by the AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India.

Or

(e) Bachelor's degree with participation in international competitions or secured 1st, 2nd or 3rd position in National/Inter-University Competition in sports and games as recognized by respective federations/ AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India.

Or

(f) Graduation with 45% marks and at least three years of teaching experience (for deputed in service candidates i.e. trained physical education teachers/coaches).

(g)

The relaxation in the percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC and other categories shall be as per the rules of the Central Government/State Government, whichever is applicable.

Eligibility Conditions for Admission to B.P.Es. Three Year Regular Course is as under:

Passed Senior Secondary School (+2) or its equivalent examination.

Note:

1. There shall be no rounding off of percentage of marks of the qualifying examination from 0.5% and above to next higher number for determining the eligibility i.e. 49.5% and above will not be rounded off to 50%.
2. 47.5% marks for SC/ST candidates of Haryana State only. As per letter dated :-16-07-2014
3. 47.5% marks for Blind /Persons with DifferentlyAbled and visually/Hearing Impaired candidate.
4. In case a candidate has passed the Master Degree Examination also after Bachelor Degree, the higher percentage of marks obtained in either of the two will be taken into consideration while preparing the merit
5. Compartmental candidates will not be allowed admission in B.Ed. (Regular Course) in any case.
6. Cut off date for eligibility will be the last date/time of online choice filling.
7. One year PG diploma in any subject will not be considered equivalent to Master's Degree.

PREPARATION OF MERIT LIST FOR ADMISSION

Merit for admission to B.Ed. course shall be determined on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination. In case a candidate has passed the Master's Degree Examination also along with Bachelor's Degree, the higher percentage of marks obtained either in Under Graduate and Post Graduate degree will be taken into consideration while determining the merit. However, if two or more candidates have obtained equal marks, following procedure will be used for the preparation of merit.

- (i) Candidate senior in age will be given first preference
- (ii) If tie still persists, then marks obtained in 12th will be considered
- (iii) If tie still persists, then marks in 10th will be considered to break the tie

Subject: Regarding prescribing minimum eligibility qualification for the various courses.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to invite your kind attention towards Government Instructions No. 3870-WGI-ASOII-64/20069 dated 6th/9th October, 1964 whereby the candidates of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes provided 5% reduction in marks in the minimum eligibility qualification for admissions in various courses.

It has come to the notice of the Government that at present where a General Category candidate is required to have 50% marks in a prescribed qualification for admission in any course, as per the above instructions a reserve category candidate is required to have 45% marks giving him 5% reduction in the minimum qualification. Vide judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court in Civil Appeal No. 7084/2011, it has been observed that the practice is wrong and the relaxation of 5% should be reduced from the minimum required marks on a general category candidate for e.g. :-

In a course, a general candidate requires to have 50% marks, than as per Govt. instructions by giving 5% relaxation the minimum eligibility marks for a reserved caste candidate should be calculated as under :-

Out of 100 Marks needs to less = 5

Out of 1 Marks needs to less = 5 / 100

Out of 50 Marks needs to less = 5 / 100 X 50 = 2.50

This way minimum less marks where general category candidates are required to have 50% in a prescribed qualification, the total required marks for a reserved candidates will be 50 - 2.50 = 47.50 and not 45.

All concerned are requested to implement the instructions as per the above procedure in the compliance of the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court passed in CWP No. 7084/2011.

ANNEXURE-I

Instructions regarding Bonafide Residents of Haryana issued vide letter No.62/17/95-6 GSI dated 3rd October, 1996, No.62/32/2000-6GSI dated 23rd May, 2003, No.62/27/2003-6GSI dated 29th July, 2003 and No.62/62/2011-6GSI dated 17th January, 2012 by the Chief Secretary to Government, Haryana.

Subject: Bonafide residents of Haryana - Guidelines regarding.

1. I am directed to invite your attention to Haryana Govt. letters noted in the margin on the subject noted above vide which the instructions were issued regarding simplification of procedure for obtaining the certificate of Domicile for the purpose of admission to educational institution (including technical /medical institution). The matter has been reconsidered in the light of judgment delivered By the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of Dr. Pradeep Jain vs. Union of India and others reported as AIR 1984-SC-1421, wherein it has been held that instead of the word 'Domicile' the word 'Resident' be used in the instructions issued by the State Government and it has been decided to revise the Government instructions. Henceforth, the following categories of persons would be eligible for the grant of Resident Certificate:-
 - (I) Candidates, who have passed the examination qualifying there for selection in an institution from a school/college in Haryana.
 - (II) Children/Wards (if parents are not living)/Dependents: -
 - (i) of the regular employees of Haryana State posted in or outside Haryana State or working on deputation;
 - (ii) of the regular employees of the statutory bodies/corporations established by or under an act of the State of Haryana who are posted in Chandigarh or in Haryana or outside Haryana.
 - (iii) of the regular employees of the Government of India posted in Chandigarh or in Haryana in connection with the affairs of the Haryana Government;
 - (III) Children/wards (if parents not living)/dependents of persons who after retirement have permanently settled in Haryana and draw their pensions from the treasuries situated in the State of Haryana.
 - (IV) Children/wards (if parents are not living)/dependents of pensioners of Haryana Government irrespective of the fact that the original home of the retiree is in a state other than Haryana or he has settled after retirement in or outside Haryana,
 - (V) Children/Wards (if parents are not living)/dependents of persons, who have permanent home in Haryana and include persons who have been residing in Haryana for a period of not less than 15 years or who have permanent home in Haryana but on account of their occupation they are living outside Haryana;
 - (VI) The wives of such persons who are bonafide residents of Haryana irrespective of the fact that they had belonged to any other State before marriage;
 - (VII) Persons who were born in Haryana and produce a certificate to that effect; provided that the parents/guardians (if parents are not living) of persons belonging to any one of the above mentioned categories are :
 - (a) Citizen of India;
 - (b) Produce an affidavit to the effect that they or their children/wards (if parents are not living)/dependents have not obtained the benefit of Resident in any other State.

(VIII) Children & Wards of the accredited journalists residing at Chandigarh and recognized by Govt. of Haryana.

2. All candidates claiming to be bonafide residents of Haryana should produce a Haryana Resident Certificate signed by the District Magistrate/GeneralAssistant to Deputy Commissioner or Sub-Divisional Officer (Civil) of the District/Sub-Divisions/Tehsildars of Revenue to which the candidates belong. Resident Certificates in respect of elsewhere or in respect of the Children/Wards/Dependents of Haryana Govt. employees who are posted at Chandigarh, Delhi or elsewhere or in respect of Children/Wards/Dependents of pensioners of Haryana Govt. or in respect of the Children/Wards/Department of the employees of the Government of India posted at Chandigarh or in Haryana in connection with the affairs of Haryana Government, or in respect of Children/Wards/Dependents of the employees and retirees of the Statutory Bodies/Corporations of Haryana established by or under an Act of the State of Haryana or a Central Act and located at Chandigarh, Haryana or outside Haryana, should be by their respective Heads of Departments.
3. Candidates seeking admission in educational institutions (including medical and technical institutions) located in Haryana may not be required to produce Resident Certificate, if they have passed the examination from a school/college situated in Haryana. For this purpose, a certificate of the Principal/Headmaster from concerned institution where the children/wards studied last should be considered sufficient. The Principal/Headmaster of the institution shall be competent to issue such certificate, which should be sufficient.
4. If a candidate is admitted on the basis of claim that he belongs to the State of Haryana but at any subsequent time is discovered that his claim was false, the student shall be removed from the institution, all fees and other dues paid up to the date of such removal shall be confiscated. The Principal/Headmaster may take such other action against the student and his/her parents/guardians as he may deem proper in the circumstances of any particular case.
5. The children/wards/dependents of the employees of Punjab & Haryana High Court, who are discharging their duties in connection with the affairs of the State of Haryana and have not availed facility from their parent State, the State of Punjab and U.T. Administration Chandigarh, would also be eligible for grant of Resident Certificate of the State of Haryana only for the purpose of admission in academic/technical/medical institutions of the State of Haryana. However, in that case the employees of the Punjab & Haryana High Court shall be entitled to draw this benefit at one place/State only. Head of the Department of the Punjab & Haryana High Court would be competent to issue such a certificate.

No 808-SW(1) - In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (d) of Section 2 of the Haryana Backward Classes (Reservation in Services and Admission in Educational Institutions) Act, 2016 (15 of 2016), the Governor of Haryana hereby specify the following criteria for exclusion of creamy layer within the Backward Classes as per the Schedules appended to the Act, namely Schedule I, II & III :-

The children of persons having gross annual income of upto Three Lakh rupees shall first of all get the benefit of reservation in services and admission in educational institutions. The left out quota shall go to that class of Backward Classes of citizens who earn more than Three Lakh rupees but upto Six Lakh rupees per annum. The sections of the Backward Classes earning above Six Lakh rupees per annum shall be considered as Creamy Layer under section 5 of the said Act.

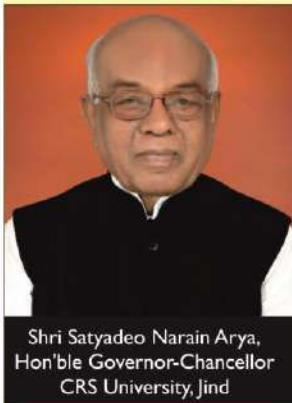

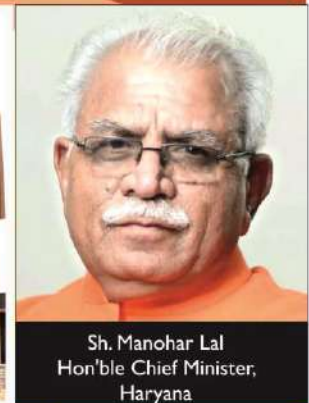
