1. Application Process

- 1. This is the application portal to apply for DoMS, IIT Madras ONLY.
- 2. Only those who are shortlisted by DoMS, IIT Madras will be invited to appear for the selection process.
- 3. Copies of necessary certificates need to be uploaded at the time of filing the application.
 - 1. Passport size photo
 - 2. Signature
 - 3. CAT score card [GMAT score card in the case of NRI]

WHICHEVER APPLICABLE

- 1. OBC(NCL) Obtained after 31st March, 2020.
- 2. EWS Obtained after 31st March, 2020.
- 3. SC/ST certificate.
- 4. PwD (Medical certificate for differently abled)
- 5. CGPA to Percentage conversion certificate.
- 6. Consolidated Grade Sheet [IIT Graduates without CAT score whose CGPA is 8.0 or above on 10 point scale]
- 4. Interview process will be conducted virtually. The necessary information will be shared with all the candidates in due course of time.
- 5. Final selection list will be announced after the completion of the selection process as per the institute norms.

2.Essential requirements

WHO CAN APPLY

- a) Graduates in any discipline from a recognised University (or a professional qualification equivalent to that of a university degree as recognised by the UGC) with a first class or 60% and above (55% for SC/ST/PwD[Differently Abled]) in the qualifying examination.
- b) Final year students (of the above-mentioned program) are also eligible to apply. Such candidates, if selected, will be admitted provisionally, on the condition that they meet all requirements for the qualifying degree before the start of the program and produce provisional certificate of completion within two months of joining the program (by September 30, 2021)
- c) Graduates in any discipline from a recognised University (or a professional qualification equivalent to that of a university degree as recognised by the UGC) with a first class or 60% and above (55% for SC/ST/PwD[Differently Abled]) in the qualifying examination.
- d) Final year students (of the above-mentioned program) are also eligible to apply. Such candidates, if selected, will be admitted provisionally, on the condition that they meet all requirements for the qualifying degree before the start of the program and produce provisional certificate of completion within two months of joining the program (by September 30, 2021)

PREREOUISITES

- a) Any Indian national with a valid score in the Common Admission Test (CAT) 2020.
- b) A foreign national with a valid GMAT score
- c) Graduates in any discipline with a valid CAT score and at least two years of work experience in the same organisation can apply under sponsored category through proper channel.(Click here to apply)

EXEMPTIONS

- a) An applicant with an undergraduate degree from any IIT and a CGPA of 8 or above on 10 point scale is exempted from the CAT requirement.
- b) Defense personnel can apply under sponsored category through proper channel and are exempted from the CAT requirement. (Click here to apply)
